“The Foundation Stage”

Kindergarten section follows the foundation stage curriculum. Our aim is to provide quality learning experiences for all the primary students by imparting structured, relevant, experimental and experiential learning. The foundation stage curriculum is divided into six areas of learning.

Personal, Social and Environmental Development:

-Good behaviour and etiquettes are encouraged.

Communication, Language and Literacy:

-To develop communication skills, activities like storytelling, recitation of poems, rhymes and songs and role-play are conducted.
-Various literary activities (recognition of alphabets, writing tasks) are carried out.

Admission Information

Information for Admission into Nursery and Class-LKG 2025-26

For the **entry class i.e. Nursery & LKG**, children whose date of birth falls between the following dates **only** are eligible for registration for the **academic session 2025-26:**

i) Nursery : 01/04/2021 to 31/03/2022 (Both days inclusive)

ii) LKG: 01/04/2020 to 31/03/2021 (Both days inclusive)

* Birth Certificate in original from the Registrar of Births & Deaths is essential at the time of admission for verification.

(In urban areas, Health Officer of the Corporation/Municipality/N.A.C, concerned is designated as "Registrar of Births & Deaths". Similarly in rural area, the Health Officer of Concerned Public Health Centre is designated as "Registrar of Births & Deaths").

* **Registration of Disadvantage group of weaker section** candidates can be done at the Govt. Portal www.rteparadarshi.odisha.gov.in in free of cost, at the time of advertisement published in local newspapers.

* Applicants for the General category, staff & Alumnus can apply online. They are required to remit an amount of **Rs. 1,000/-** online through **Debit Card / Credit Card / Net Banking.**

Special Category: Admission under the special category would be made as per the **government guidelines and instructions** for the session 2025-26.

* For Disadvantaged Group (SC/ST/SEBC-Non-Creamy Layer) & Economically Weaker Section:

(i) In case of SC/ST/ SEBC candidates, Original and attested photocopy of Caste Certificate issued by competent authority.

(ii) Identity proof/Address proof of Parents/Guardians can be the Aadhaar card/Driving License/Voter ID/KCC Card/electricity Bill/water bill/ Gas bill/ Passport/PAN Card/MNREGA job Card/Photo attested by any Gazetted officer/Certificate in support of Address given by the Sarpanch/Counsellor/Corporator/Local MLA/Gazetted Officer written on their Letterhead

* Any poverty alleviation card issued by the Govt./Certificate of income issued by the competent authority in case of EWS candidates.

* Disability Certificate for children with disabilities (not less than 40%)/CWC certificate in case of orphan issued by competent authority / CWC

* Aadhaar Number of the child is essential for admission.

* After submission of application through the respective online portal, parents and/or guardian of eligible students need to visit the office of the Block Education Officer (BEO), Bhubaneswar along with original copies of necessary documents. The BEO will validate the application and forward it to the directorate of Elementary Education through the portal.

* Candidates will be allotted seats in different schools through online lottery considering their priority & category as per the policy of the government.

To Be Noted: Registration fee is not refundable.

Every year, we have more applicants than the number of seats available.

Therefore, if a candidate is unable to secure a seat, it is in no way a reflection of his/her calibre.

Admission into Other Classes

Forms will be issued to the applicant provided there is vacancy. Priority shall be given to applicants whose parent gets a transfer from outstations. Presence of parents (father and mother) is essential at the time of admission. Transfer certificate obtained from the previous school duly countersigned by the District Education Officer of Schools/ Dy. Director of Education / Regional Officer of authentication shall be verified.

Fee has to be deposited by the stipulated date, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next wait-listed candidate.

However, in case of Std I and Std XI, the school conducts Personal Interviews and Screening Tests for admission of candidates.

Std. I & II: English, Hindi/Odia, EVS, Maths, Art & Craft, Music, HPER, Computer, Moral Education.

Std III to IV: English, Environmental Studies, Mathematics, Art, Craft, HPER, Music, General Knowledge, Moral Education, Hindi/Odia, Computer Science. *Apart from English only one more language will be offered.*

Std.V to VIII: English, Hindi, Odia, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Dharma Siksha/Moral Education, General Knowledge, Computer Science (*Work Experience*), Health and Physical Education, Art Education. *[From Std. VI onwards]*

N.B. Apart from English, Hindi and Odia to be opted as either Higher or Lower Language.

Std. IX & X: English Language and Literature, Hindi / Odia / Sanskrit, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Computer Science, IT, Work Experience, Health and Physical Education, Art Education.

Std. XI & XII: *Compulsory Subjects:* English Core, Work Experience, Health and Physical Education, General Studies.

For +2 Science:

Elective: **Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Computer Science, Physical Education, Painting & Economics.**

{N.B.: Minimum 4 electives have to be taken including Physics & Chemistry.}



For + 2 Commerce:

Electives: **Economics, Accountancy, Business Studies, Mathematics, Physical Education, Entrepreneurship & Painting.**

{N.B.: Minimum 4 electives have to be taken including Accountancy, Business Studies and Economics.}



For + 2 Humanities:

Electives: **Psychology, History, Geography, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Physical Education & Painting.**

{N.B : Minimum 4 electives have to be taken}
